Program: The presentation will describe a \$15 million project currently underway to renovate and upgrade the 5-megawatt hydroelectric power plant owned by the City of Columbus and located at O'Shaughnessy Dam. The history of the power plant, an overview of the project scope as well as current status will be described. This facility began producing power in 1987 under a federal program to reduce reliance on foreign oil. It was in disrepair and shut down in 2017. The renovation is funded by a City of Columbus Bond issue as part of a goal to move toward green and sustainable energy sources.

Presented by: The speaker will be Mr. Justin Lusiak, construction manager for Prime AE Group Inc. that has the contract to manage this project. Mr. Lusiak is a Certified Construction Manager with over 20 years of experience managing civil engineering projects for the City of Columbus and Prime AE.
